



MEDICINE MANAGEMENT


Annual medicine management updates for RNs were delivered virtually using ECHO methodology. A programme of four sessions consisting was developed:

- Effective medicine management including incidents
- Opioid toxicity and dose conversions
- Assessment and management of nausea and vomiting
- Pharmacy update

Programme was delivered 5 times over a period of 10 months in collaboration with PPWH.
