### Val & Alex's Story

# A love that lasted a lifetime



Val and Alex Lawson shared 46 years of marriage - a life filled with laughter, love, and deep connection. Their story began in the Station Bar in Paisley, where Alex, in a moment of nervous excitement, spilled a drink on Val's brand-new top. It was an awkward start to something beautiful.

They married in 1978, less than a year later, and built a life together in McKerrell Street. Val worked as a nurse, including a role at ACCORD Hospice in the early '90s, while Alex took on various jobs - from mechanic to HGV driver. Together, they raised their children Gary and Kayleigh, always holding close the memory of their daughter Melanie, who passed away at just 14 weeks.

In early 2025, after months of back pain and fatigue, Alex was diagnosed with terminal cancer. He wanted to stay at

home, and that's when ACCORD stepped in. Dr Bishop and the ACCORD@Home team provided compassionate, honest, and deeply personal care. A hospice bed was set up in the spare room, allowing Alex to remain part of the family home.

The nurses brought not just medical support, but warmth and humour. Alex, ever the joker, would pretend to be asleep when they arrived. Val noticed how peaceful and dignified he looked

after their visits. Most importantly, everything was done on Alex's terms.

Val says the care allowed her to stop being a carer and simply be his wife again. Alex passed away peacefully on 21 April 2025.

Since then, Val has leaned on ACCORD's bereavement support. "I've gone from being a 'we' to a 'me'," she said. "The grief is raw, but the support is helping me find my feet again."

# Love found us when we thought life was over

On a bright day at The Busby Hotel - surrounded by family, friends, their walking group, and the ACCORD team - John and Louise said, "I do."

Neither thought they'd find love again. John had lost his wife Brenda during lockdown; Louise's husband Alan died suddenly after cancer returned. Both were left with a silence no one prepares you for. That's when ACCORD reached out - with counselling, with the Walking with Grief group, with gentle kindness.

On those walks, they found people who understood. And, unexpectedly, they found each other. It began with a garden, grew into dinners, cinema trips, and laughter - until love quietly bloomed again. This spring, they became husband and wife.



Brenda and Alan will always be part of their story, but John and Louise carry that love forward into this new chapter - proof that even in the depths of grief, something beautiful can grow.

# A quality framework for care homes for adults and older people



#### 1. Compassionate, skilled care

The inspection highlighted that the ACCORD@Home team are **highly trained, motivated, and compassionate**, providing care that makes a real difference to people's lives.

#### 2. Helping families keep loved ones at home

Families shared how the service **enabled loved ones to stay at home with dignity**, fulfilling their wishes at the end of life while also supporting carers.

#### 3. A lifeline for carers

Relatives consistently said the service **reduced stress, provided reassurance, and helped them cope** during difficult times, describing the staff as "amazing" and "a great support."

#### 4. Respected by healthcare professionals

Local healthcare teams described ACCORD@Home as an **essential, responsive service** that provides emotional as well as clinical support, with one consultant calling it "a super service... we are privileged to have it here."

#### 5. Rated 'Very Good' in key areas

The Care Inspectorate awarded ACCORD@Home 'Very Good' ratings for supporting wellbeing, staff, and care planning and a strong 'Good' rating for leadership.
